Fisher College is accredited by the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE) and the Commission on Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management Education (CAHIIM). The School of Management and Communications has received specialized accreditation for its business programs through the International Accreditation Council for Business Education (IACBE).

Degrees Offered

Fisher College offers the Bachelor of Arts (BA) and Bachelor of Science (BS) degrees as well as the Associate of Science (AS) degree, and the MBA Master of Business Administration in Strategic Leadership, with possible added focus in Accounting or Sport Administration.

Student Success

95% of graduates are employed or continuing their education within one year of graduation. The Academic Center for Enrichment is staffed with 15-20 professional tutors available to assist students with organizational and study skills, the learning process and academic intervention.
