Academics

Hebron Academy follows an education model based on student-centered teaching and learning through a comprehensive liberal arts curriculum, complemented by a range of electives. Students can explore the arts through courses in music, chorus, orchestra, studio art and photography, digital art and media, and audio recording and production. Students also learn and practice public speaking in a variety of settings from interviews to addressing the school, as part of the "Words" program at Hebron.

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

10 available including: English Literature & Composition, Calculus AB, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics C, Psychology, US History, Music Theory, and Studio Art.

ESL Program

The ESL Program integrates listening, speaking, reading, and writing into three levels: Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced. The levels are designed to meet the needs of a variety of students and offer flexibility in transition to the school. The program also offers ESL support in academic areas including Literature, Mathematics, Science and History.

Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

Campus Life

The campus offers extensive outdoor activities and resources including miles of trails and track, and is home to the Williams Athletic Center with rock-climbing wall, squash courts, weight room, yoga and dance studio, tennis courts, track, basketball courts and batting cage; a Turf Field and Robinson Ice Hockey Arena; the LePage Center for the Visual and Performing Arts; and the new Kaneb Center for Science and Engineering (STEM) which opened in 2019. There are also 3 dormitories on campus with common spaces in each and staffed by school faculty who reside on each floor of the residences.

Activities

Students at Hebron Academy are very involved in school life, participating in community service, and joining various clubs and after school activities, including Model UN, Robotics, Student Government, Yearbook, Science Olympiad and more. Special events held at the school throughout the year foster a feeling of community and school spirit!

Sports

Teams include: Baseball (boys), Basketball, Cross Country, Field Hockey (girls), Football (boys), Golf, Ice Hockey, Lacrosse, Mountain Biking, Skiing (Alpine & Nordic), Snowboarding, Soccer, Softball (girls), Tennis, and Track & Field.
