### Academics

Maine Central Institute's math and science programs exceed national standards and utilize state-of-the-art technology and academic facilities. Students in the humanities program understand the culture of an era through a study of its history, literature and art. In addition to these and available Advanced Placement courses, students can excel in Drama, Music, and Visual Arts. Maine Central Institute is also home to the Bossov Ballet Theatre, which is both a performing company, as well as an international pre-professional ballet school and offers the unique opportunity for students to study classical ballet as part of the academic curriculum.

### Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

12 available including: English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, US History, US Government & Politics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Biology, Physics C Mechanics, Physics C Electricity & Magnetism, Environmental Science, Computer Science A, and Computer Science Principles.

### ESL Program

Maine Central Institute founded one of the first ESL programs in Maine, and currently offers a wide range of courses in 3 ESL levels to support academic study and TOEFL and SAT test preparation.

### Success Rate

98% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

### Campus Life

The campus was established in 1866 and has historic buildings dating back to 1869. The beautiful campus features a state-of-the-art Math and Science Center, library, music building, two gymnasiums, four residence halls, ballet studio and the MCI Trustee Memorial Student Center, which houses the dining hall, performance stage, food court, and game room. Boarding students reside in single-sex residences on campus, supervised by resident faculty and staff. Each residence has its own recreation and laundry rooms.

### Activities

Athletics and activities play an important educational role at Maine Central Institute. Students are required to either participate in one full season of a sport, or to be active in at least one other club or activity. Leadership opportunities are also available in Student Council, Dorm Council, and in the numerous clubs on campus.

### Sports

Teams include: Baseball (boys), Basketball, Field Hockey (girls), Football (boys), Golf, Indoor Track, Lacrosse, Rifle team, Soccer, Softball (girls), Tennis, Track & Field, and Wrestling (boys). Independent teams also include Skiing and Swimming.
