Uniforms

Uniforms are not required, but there is a Dress Code for all students to follow

Academics

Students learn in a pristine natural environment with extensive resources for academic studies, arts, athletics and scientific inquiry, especially, in partnership with the University of Washington's Friday Harbor Labs. Unique courses offered include: Ceramics, Environmental Systems, Statistics, Theatre, and Creative Writing.

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

5 available including: English Literature & Composition, Spanish Language & Culture, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, and Psychology.

ESL Program

At Spring Street International School, the approach to ESL is through immersion, supported by individual and small-group tutorial instruction. Each student is assessed twice per year in writing, grammar, reading and listening, and is placed in classes appropriate to their needs. ESL classes are offered at three levels: Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced.

Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

Campus Life

Spring Street International School opened a beautiful 5,200 square foot dormitory on campus in January 2013. This facility has 9 two-person rooms and is equipped with a large living and dining space, full kitchen, laundry facilities and terrace. It is staffed by full time dorm parents who support and advise the students in an intimate, family environment. The dormitory is also a short walk from downtown central Friday Harbor.

Activities

Students are encouraged to participate in local activities such as athletic programs through the public high school, use of the local athletic club, participation in the vibrant community theater, and to take advantage of the beautiful natural environment through hikes, walks, bike rides, and trips to the beaches. High School students are also required to complete 20 hours of community service each year.

Sports

Students are eligible and encouraged to participate in team sports offered by the local public schools. Teams include: Baseball, Basketball, Soccer, Softball, Swimming, Tennis, and Track & Field.
